Mdm. AMBIGA: An FLC Story from Malaysia

An elderly care center was closing down last year and the residents were relocated. Among them was Mdm.Ambiga, a 74 year old single woman. She was suffering from chronic asthma coupled with acute knee problems that greatly hampered her mobility. She needed medical care and most homes for the senior citizens were not willing to take her because she could not afford to pay for her upkeep. The only resort for her was the government funded old folks homes that are poorly kept and managed.

By God's grace, we at Shekinah Home were able to embrace her and give her a refuge. This was made possible simply because of the generosity of many well-wishers and donations like the FLC grant. The day Mdm Ambiga arrived at our home, she was crying.' Will you beat me?' 'I don't know what to do'. She was very afraid.

After almost 18 months, she is a different person today. Her asthma is under control with daily medication. She moves around slowly with the help of a walker. Gone is her fear. She worships God with great joy and her faith in God is unshakeable.'I have you to love me and God to protect me...I am thankful'. These are her words just two days ago.

I thank God that in a small way we have made a difference in the life of this one woman and given her the dignity and self worth even in old age.

Thank you for the grant. It has indeed made life worth living for Mdm.Ambiga in her twilight years.
